Henri Matisse Cutting with Scissors

Today we are going to use what we learnt last week on colour theory and create a collage making use of good contrasting and complementary colours.

Look at the examples of Henri Matisse's work below. He created these pieces by cutting shapes straight into coloured paper. He did not draw with a pencil first.

Can you spot any contrasting colours? Any warm or cool colours?



Task: Can you create your own 'under the sea' collage picture using the cutting with scissors technique? Remember do not draw with a pencil first and then stick layers over each other to make a collage. Choose your colours wisely!

<u>Alternative:</u> You could create a picture using block colours and shapes on the computer, or with coloured pencils.
