Computing

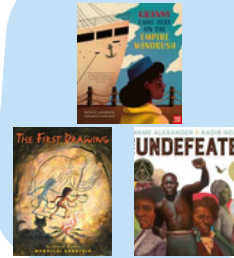
We will become coding experts as well as learning about branching databases

Art
