Descriptive Writing: Setting Description

We read yesterday about Michael who is visiting his family who live on a farm in Wales. The book provides us with good detail about the setting on page 1 and 2, you could re-read this section to re-fresh your memory.

Task 1: Look at the picture below. This could be similar to the setting in the book. Think about how you would describe it using expanded noun phrases.



Task 2: I would like you to imagine you are Michael and you have just arrived at the farm. Close your eyes and imagine what it looks like. What can you hear? What can you smell?

Using your imaginations, experiences from the beach and details from the book, can you write a postcard to Mum at home, telling her about your first few hours at the farm.

Remember:

- √ Please include good description. Expanded noun phrases and prepositional phrases (Y4).
- √ Good use of punctuation. (Full stops, capital letters, exclamation marks, brackets)
- √ Write in full, detailed sentences.
- √ Describe what the place looks like, smells like, things you can do there? Ideas are in the book to help you.
